1. Receive the Minutes of the March 21, 2025, Meeting

The minutes of the March 21, 2025 Economic Development Board meeting were unanimously approved.

2. Downtown District Initiative

Staff presented the Downtown District Initiative that will explore the creation of a Historic Preservation Ordinance and/or the establishment of a Creative Arts District to preserve Stanwood's unique heritage, support the local arts community, and stimulate long-term economic growth.

3. Public Art Project

Board members shared ideas for public art projects such as painting transformer boxes, hanging movable art banners, interesting pavement patterns, and a mural on the wall of the building at Depot Park.

4. Tourism Promotion Grant

All were in favor of recommending the Twin City Idlers Car Show for the grant.

5. State Route 532 Intersection Control Evaluation

Take into consideration that a roundabout at SR 532 and 102nd Avenue could be dangerous for pedestrians. The Board would like to see an example of a roundabout that has a lot of pedestrian activity, like the one in Burlington.

6. Business License Analytics

In March and April, the City received 12 City Business Licenses, 13 Home Occupation Licenses, 3 Non-Profit Licenses and 42 Non-City Business Licenses.

Storefront Improvement Program

BACKGROUND

The City of Stanwood has a rich history, with many historic and unique buildings, housing locally owned businesses in the downtown commercial retail area.

In 2023, City Council approved the Storefront Improvement Program. The Storefront Improvement Program is intended to both preserve and enhance the character and charm of downtown Stanwood, while also encouraging investment in downtown through physical and visual improvements to storefront buildings. The Storefront Improvement Program incentivizes businesses and property owners to make improvements to the appearance of their buildings by offering up to \$20,000 in matching grant funds for qualifying projects. Storefront improvements that are eligible for reimbursement include, but are not limited to: exterior paint, roofs and awnings, doors and windows, streetscapes and signage.

In 2023, the city received ten Storefront Improvement Program inquiries which resulted in five applications being submitted and approved by City Council, totaling \$52,971 in project funds. In 2024, City Council approved three Storefront Improvement Program applications totaling \$78,396 in grant dollars spent from 2023-2024.

The city has entered the 2025-2026 budget cycle and has \$50,000 in available Storefront Improvement Program grant funding this year. One application has been approved so far totaling \$3,145.33 in allocated grant dollars. Below are two applications for the Economic Development Board's consideration.

ANALYSIS

Stanwood Hotel Saloon Storefront Improvement Program Application

Historical Narrative: Stanwood Hotel Saloon is in west-downtown Stanwood and is one of the city's oldest buildings. The original building was constructed after the 1892 fire that destroyed most of the buildings in Stanwood at the time. Historically, the Stanwood Hotel Saloon served as a gathering place for businessmen, loggers, millworkers, hunters and the occasional tourist. To this day, the hotel still serves beer, food and hosts music.

In 2024, staff held a pre-application meeting with current owners, Marilyn and Leonard, and are in support of their proposed improvements. Note, the quote and pricing provided below is for the two street facing sides of the building, which are eligible for grant funding.

ANALYSIS

Curated Storefront Improvement Program Application

Curated, previously the location of Doilies to Doorknobs, is located on Mainstreet in east-Stanwood and is operated by Jeff Spesock. City staff met with Jeff earlier this year. Jeff is interested in replacing an aging, dated awning cover with new fabric to enhance the overall curb appeal of the building.

If the two presented applications are approved by the Economic Development Board and then Council, **\$28,585.83** in grant dollars will be awarded with **\$21,414.17** remaining available.

Grant Requests

Background

Stanwood City Council established and funds the Special Events and Tourism Promotion Grant Program under Resolution No. 2018-13. The program is designed to support community events that attract visitors from outside the Stanwood area, thereby promoting tourism and economic activity. Grant requests are reviewed by the Economic Development Board and awarded by the Mayor. Events drawing fewer than 4,000 participants may be eligible for grants up to \$1,000, while events expecting over 4,000 attendees may receive up to \$2,000. All applicants must provide matching funds equal to at least 50% of the requested grant amount.

Tourism Promotion Grant – MAC Fest

MAC Fest is a four-day arts festival running August 29-September 1, 2025. Events, classes and exhibits will happen throughout the day, every day. True to SCAAC’s mission, this festival works collaboratively with artists and organizations to build community through the arts. This is the second year that SCAAC is putting on MAC Fest, so we are eager to continue momentum and marketing efforts to attract an even larger audience this year. As part of the four-day festival, there are multiple events for which out-of-town visitors will want to spend the night at a nearby hotel. Evening events will run until 10pm and daytime events will begin as early as 9am. MAC Fest also includes the On the Brick Road Block Party featuring live music, food trucks, market vendors and more on the Brick Road. The estimated number of attendees for MAC Fest is 1,500. **The total funding request is \$1,000.** The total event budget for MAC Fest this year is \$36,000 with over \$8,000 allocated for marketing and advertising.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommend approving the Tourism Promotion Grant for MAC Fest in the amount of \$1,000.

Tourism Promotion Grant – Rotary Parade

The Stanwood Camano Rotary Parade is a long-standing event that coincides with the Stanwood Camano Fair. The event is a great example of the community spirit that is seen in Stanwood every day and attracts over 8,000 attendees and overnight stays. The total event budget for the Rotary Parade is \$4,000. **The total funding request is \$2,000.**

Staff Recommendation: Given the thousands of attendees this event attracts to Stanwood’s downtown corridor, staff recommend approving the requested grant amount of \$2,000.

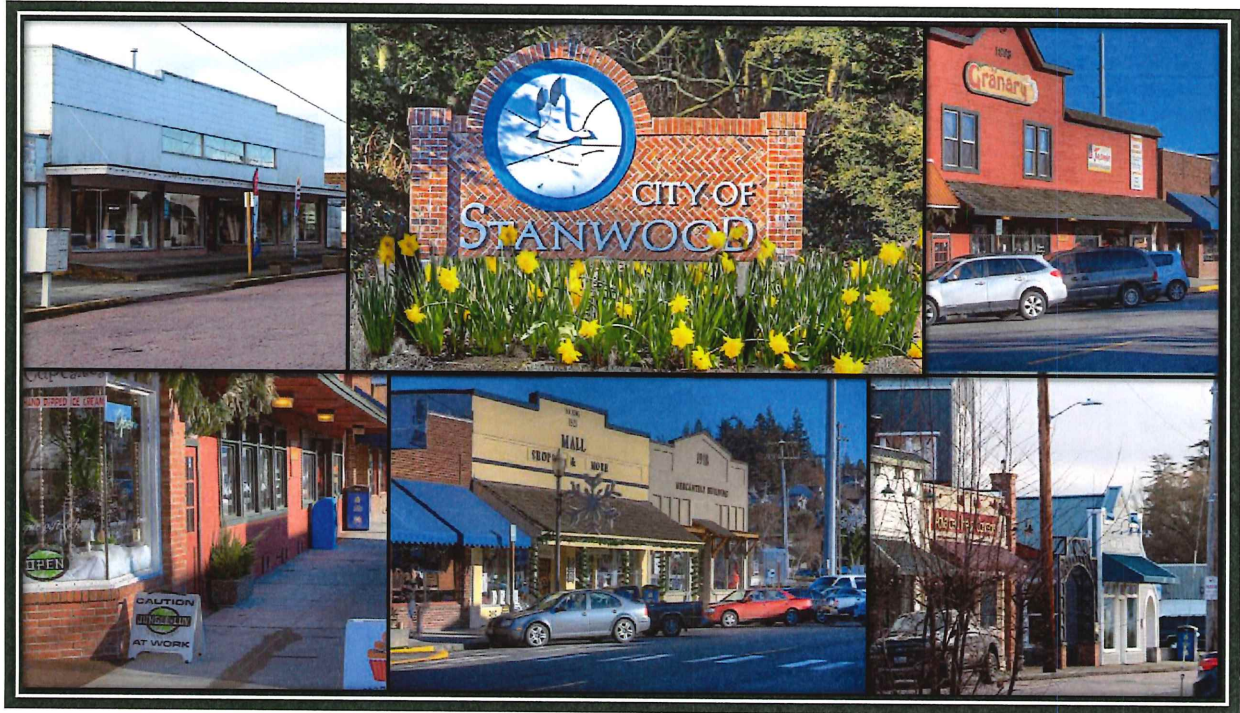
Grant Budget Summary
