Les Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:34 a.m.

1. Receive the Minutes of the January 20, 2023 Meeting

The minutes of the January 20, 2023 Economic Development Board were approved unanimously.

2. City Beautification: West End Gateway Project Narrative

Patricia Love gave an overview on the West End Gateway Project. The Board approves of this project. Suggestions from Board members included: string a cable across the Gateway to hang banners from; consider solar lighting; use standard poles with art attached instead of poles being a part of the art; and incorporate other budgets to make sidewalks ADA compliant.

3. City Beautification: Downtown Park Project Narrative

Board members had the following ideas for the downtown park: bring in a rail car or caboose; add a gazebo or silo style gazebo; add benches, tables, and chairs. The Board also likes the name "Railroad Park" for the property.

4. City Beautification: Banner Project/88th Ave Arch Project

The Banner Project/88th Ave Arch design is at 100% and went out for bid. The bids came in higher than expected. The Board suggested creating a contest for people to win a chance to put their artwork on the arch, represent different Stanwood groups on the columns, and allow public and/or private opportunities for sponsorship.

5. Storefront Improvement Program Update

Sarah Cho updated the Board on new applications for the Storefront Improvement Program and how popular it has become.

6. Special Event/Tourism Promotion Grant

Sarah Cho updated the Board on upcoming special events and the tourism promotion grant. The Pickers Market is on May 13th, the Farmers Market will be from June 2 – October 6, and the Twin City Idlers will be in town on June 25th. The EDB approves this grant.

7. Business License Analytics

For the month of February 2023, 34 business licenses were processed. 20 of the licenses were non-resident business licenses, 10 were home occupation licenses, and 4 were city businesses.

8. Discover Stanwood Camano Analytics

In February, the DSC website had 1,830 user visits. There was a total of 3,295 pageviews. The top five states for audience locations were Washington, Wyoming, California, Texas, and Oregon. The Facebook page reached 2,563 people with 619 page visits and the Instagram account reached over 1,630 people with 234 profile visits. The top 5 search terms were Northwest Glass Quest, Camano Island, Stanwood Senior Center, Glass Quest, and Camano Island Washington.

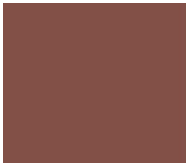

PROJECT SUMMARY

Objective

To have a more inviting area that will encourage walk by traffic and improve the look of the neighborhood. While retaining the historical look of the city.

Project Outline

There are three parts that together will have a real effect on the storefront.

- Replacing thirteen outdated single pane windows. These will be in the same basic size and will have a small vinyl frame. This will retain a closer look to original than a modern aluminum storefront style but will give a cleaner look than the current windows. Sahara Pizza will not be using the Pepsi window logo with the new windows.
- Replacing four old doors, these are well worn. The new doors are wood and will be of the original design. The Pepsi logo will not be replaced on Sahara's south door.
- Completing the paint on the upper portion of the front and south side of the building. The bay window on the south, that fronts the Stanwood Hotel will have trim detail repainted also.

Project Implementation

- When possible I tried to work with Stanwood businesses. For the windows it wasn't possible as these are a speciality type of window (commercial) that in city glass shops will not work with. The doors are special order as well, Frank Lumber being the only place I could find that could order them. K&K Finishers will do the painting. They are a Stanwood paint contractor, I have used them in the past and they are very good.
 - Window installation is by Glasstek out of Bellingham. I contacted several other commercial glass companies, one did not return with a quote. Another suggested aluminum storefront style windows (like Bank America has etc). These would run in range of \$55,000 and would have a more modern cold look.
 - I will be doing the door installation. I have done this on Panini's main entrance door. The current old doors are fit in to the solid door frame, this is part of the building structure, it is not a traditional modern door frame. I will remove the old door and bring to Frank Lumber for their matching service (\$100 each) they router the hinges in, cut the lock set in the exact position of the old door. They are the only shop doing this and its critical for this job.
-

Project Scheduling

- Windows and doors are special order. Windows approximately six weeks from order date. Doors are two weeks approximately. I have spoke with both contractors on timing.
- Glasstek approximately late June, possibly July.
- K&K needs good weather, no rain and calm wind (they will be on a 35' arial lift). June is the target date.
- Doors I can have in a week or two after receiving them. I will need to stain them (this saves several thousand over farming that out). Target is mid- June.

Discover Stanwood Camano Analytics for March 2023

For the month of March 2023, Discover Stanwood Camano had 1,595 users (-12.84%) visit the website for at least one session. There was also a total of 2,619 pageviews (-20.52%). 64.6% of the audience found the website through organic search, 27% of the audience found the website through direct search, 6.7% of the audience found the website through a referral, and 1.7% of the audience found the website through social.

The top five states for audience location were Washington with 834 visitors, California with 187 visitors, Wyoming with 174 visitors, Oregon with 46 visitors and Texas with 30 visitors. In Washington State, the audience location breakdown was Seattle with 265 visitors, not set (no known location) with 168 visitors, Camano with 61 visitors, Marysville with 29 visitors, Mount Vernon with 27 visitors, Everett with 25 visitors and Bellevue with 16 visitors.

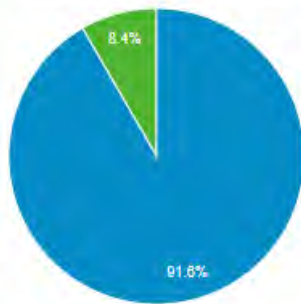

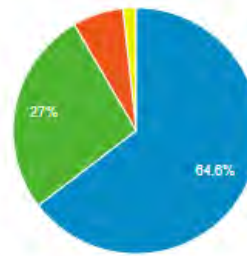

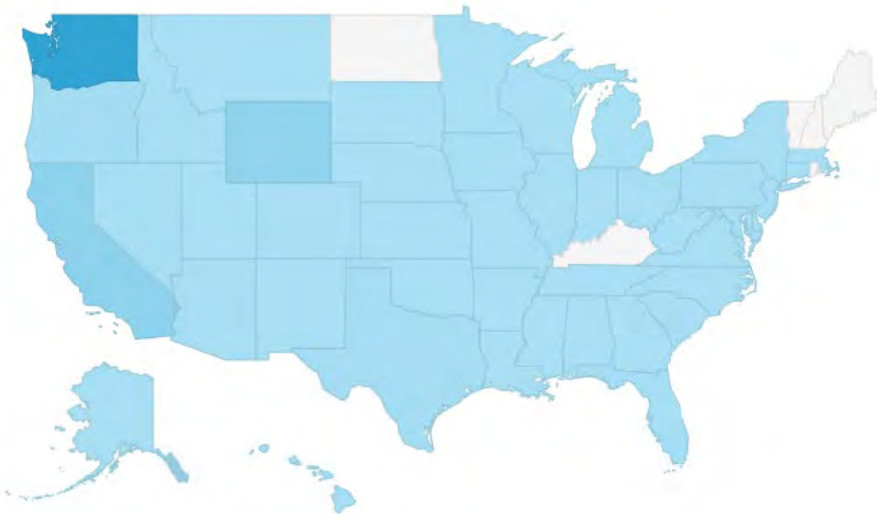
